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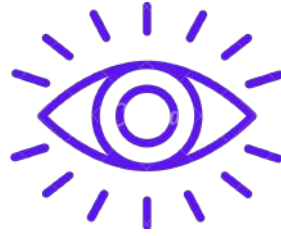

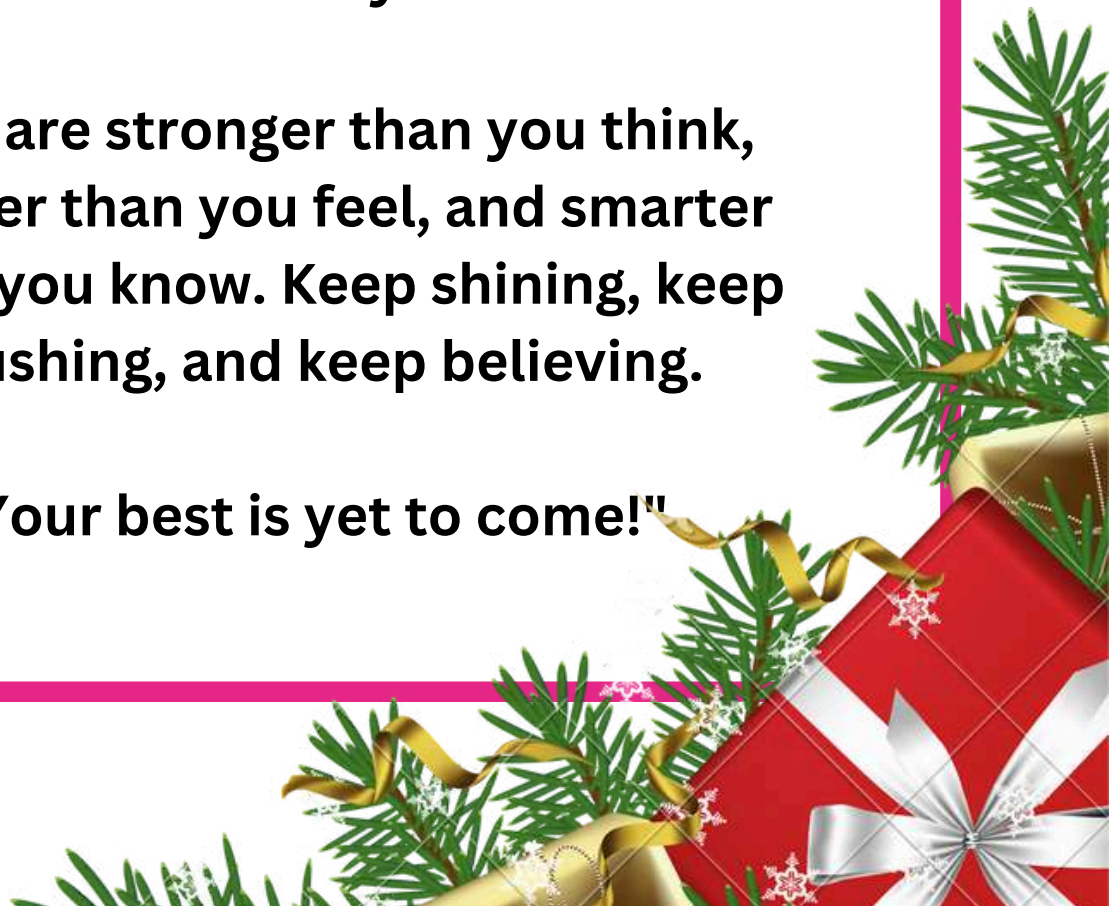

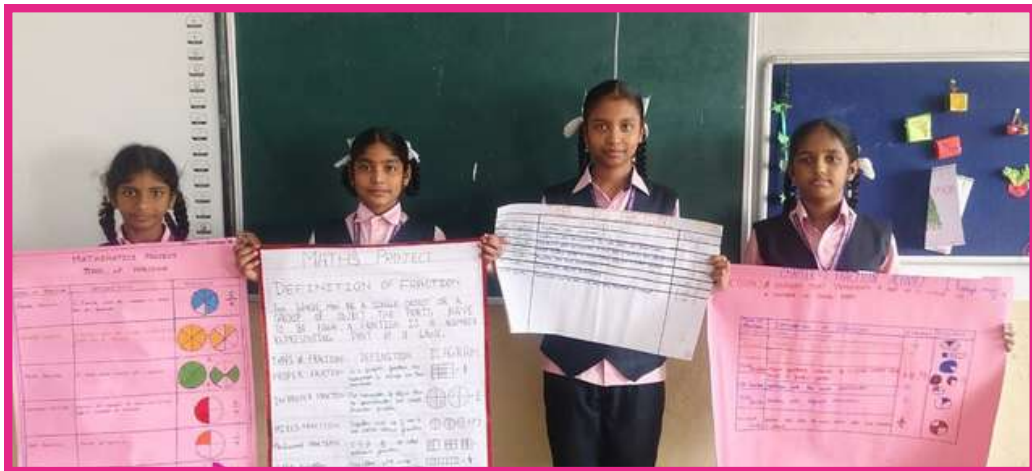

GRAMMAR CAPSULE

The word "capsule" has multiple meanings, including:

A part of a plant that forms a case or container for seeds, fruit, or spores.

A structure that encloses a body part, such as the eyeball or lens capsule.

A paintball projectile filled with water-soluble dye.

A hotel that offers cheap accommodation in very small compartments.

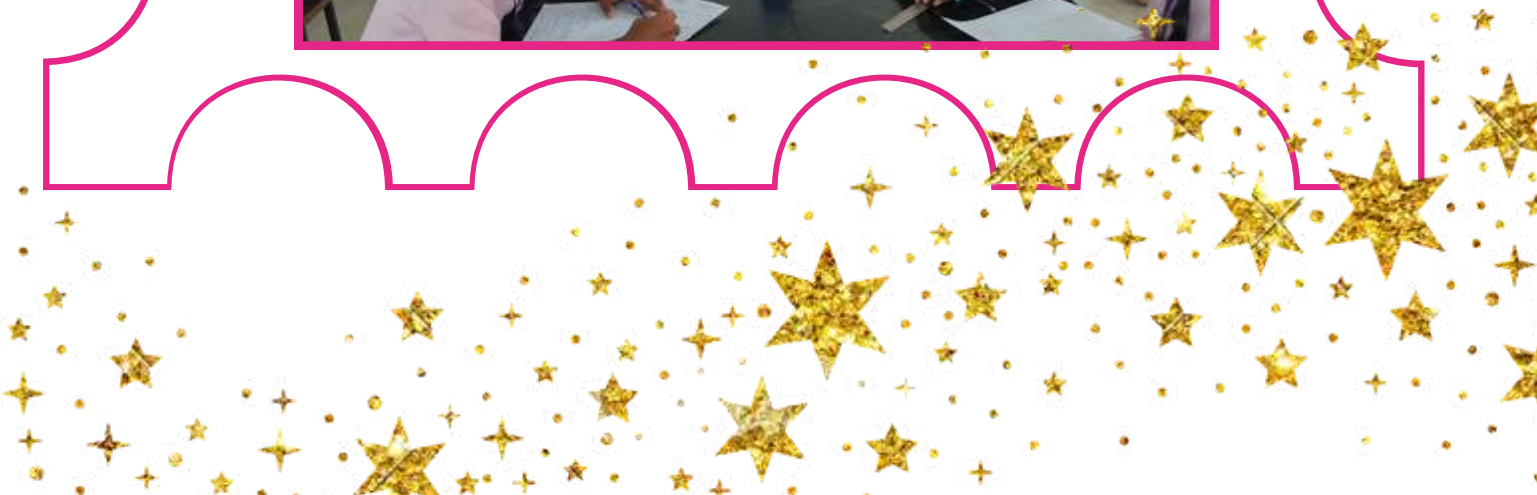
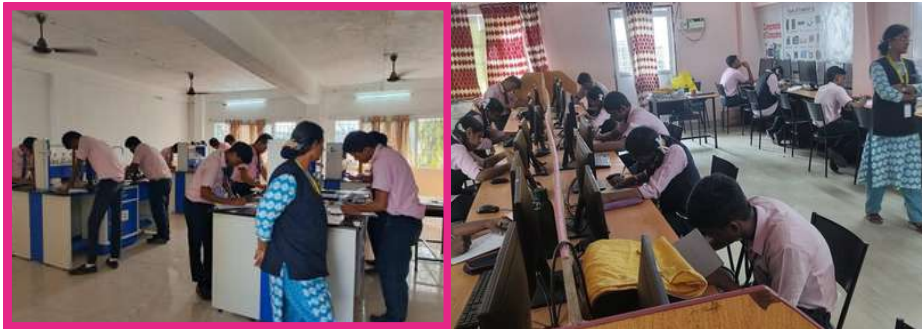
The word "capsule" comes from the French word capsule, which comes from the Latin word capsula, a diminutive of capsa meaning box.

Creativity: ECAs help students discover and develop their creativity.

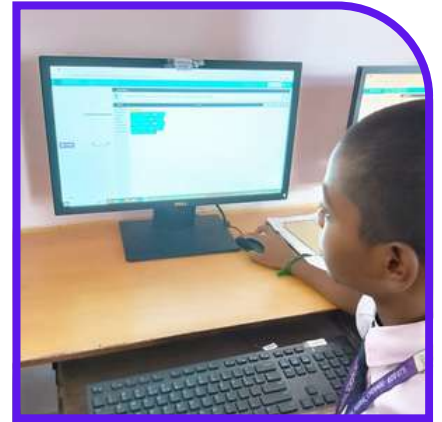
Confidence: ECAs help students develop confidence in themselves and their abilities.

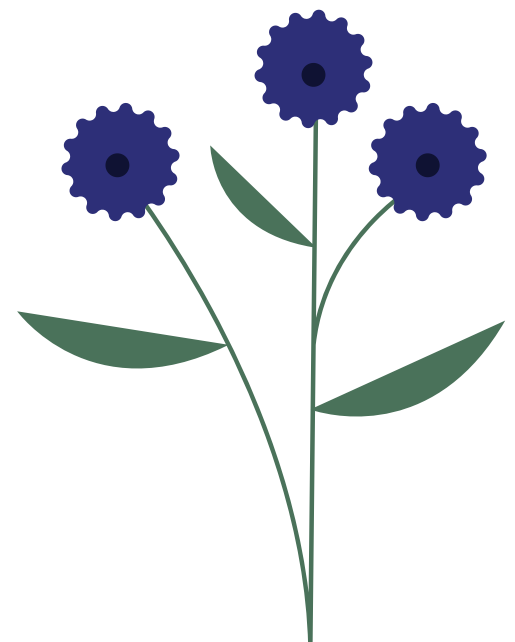
