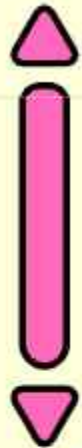

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# facts about July



**Origin of the Name:** July is named after Julius Caesar, the Roman general and statesman who was born on July 12th. The month was originally called Quintilis in Latin, meaning fifth month, before it was renamed in honor of Caesar.

**National Ice Cream Month:** In the United States, July is celebrated as National Ice Cream Month, with National Ice Cream Day falling on the third Sunday of the month (July 21 in 2024).

**Birthstone:** The birthstones for July are the ruby and onyx. Rubies are considered symbols of love and passion, while onyx is associated with protection and strength.
