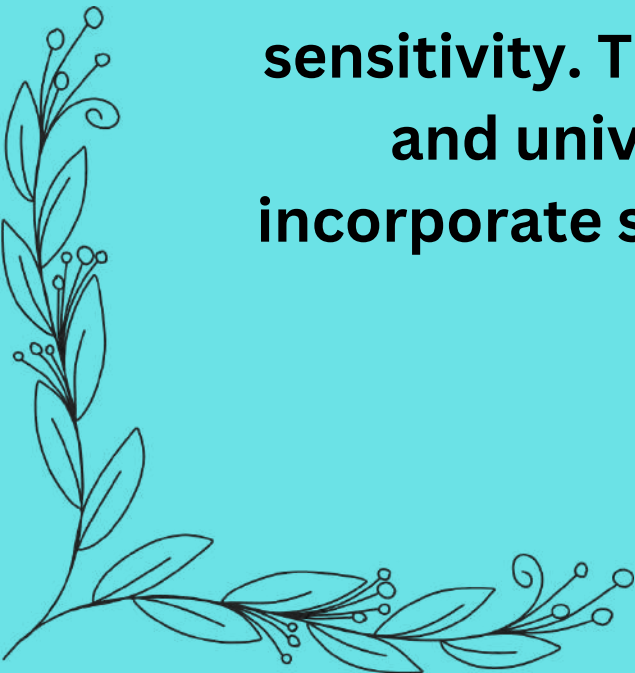




# CAMPUS SUPERIOR MESSAGE


# PRINCIPAL MESSAGE

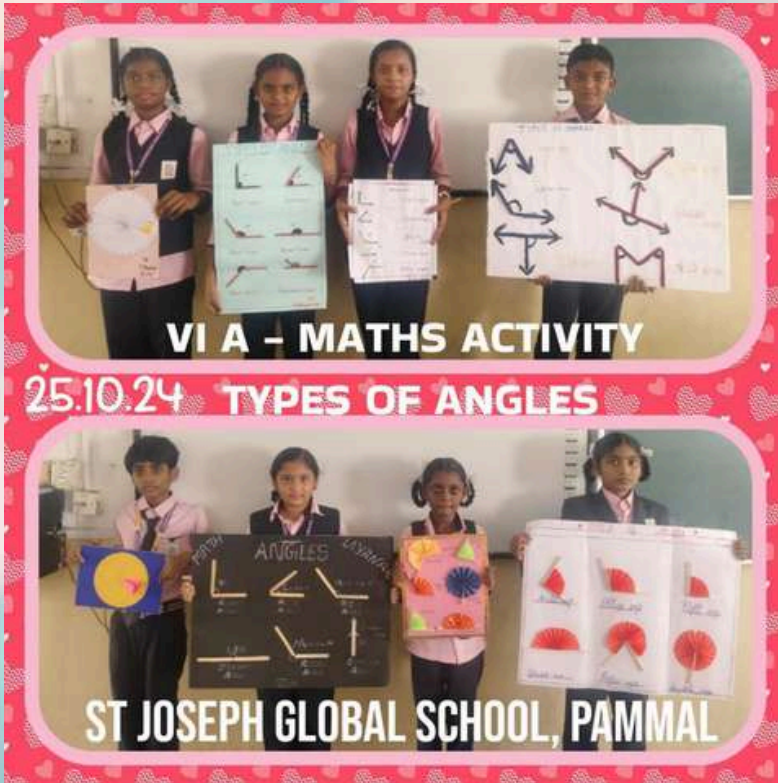


Origami is the traditional Japanese art of paper folding, which has become a popular activity worldwide.

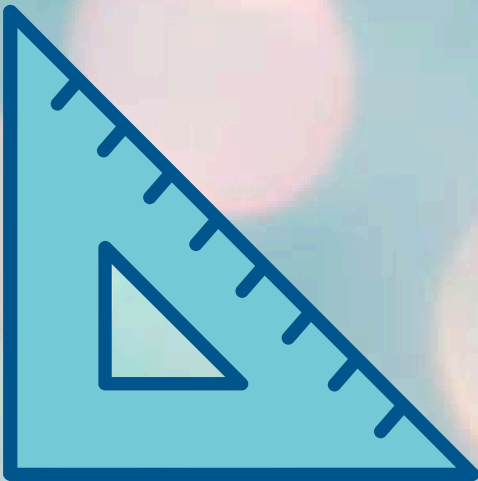

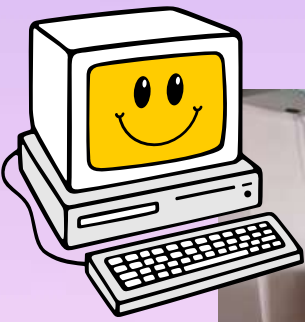


Learning about angles is a fundamental concept in geometry and mathematics.

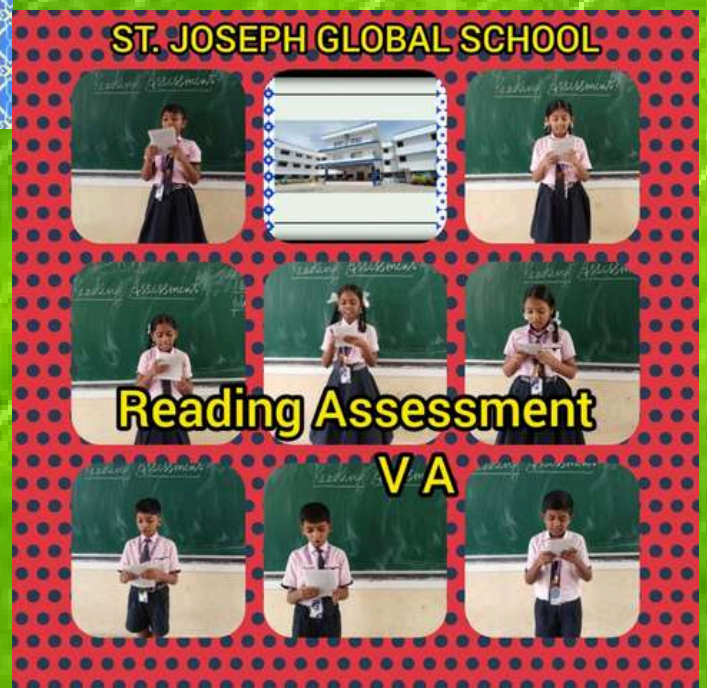
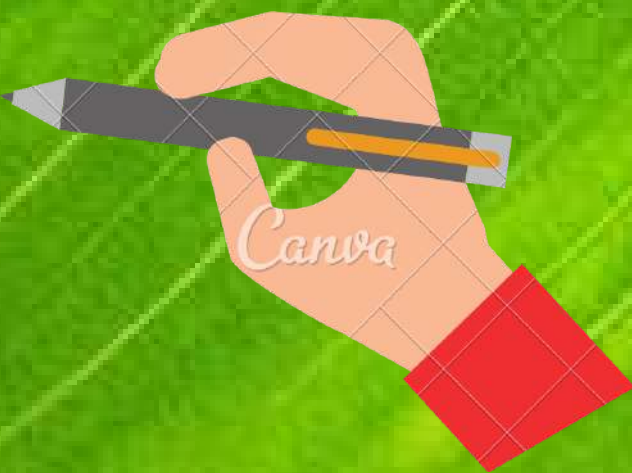
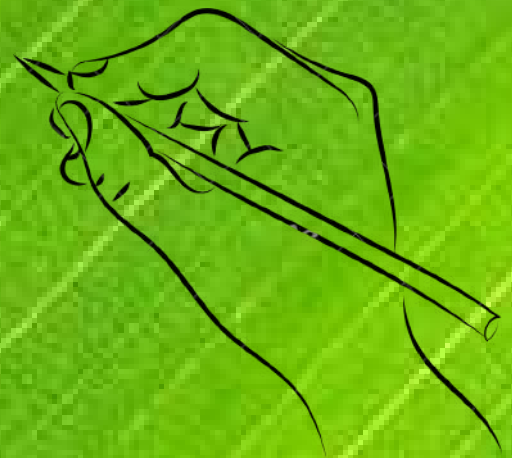


# HANDWRITING

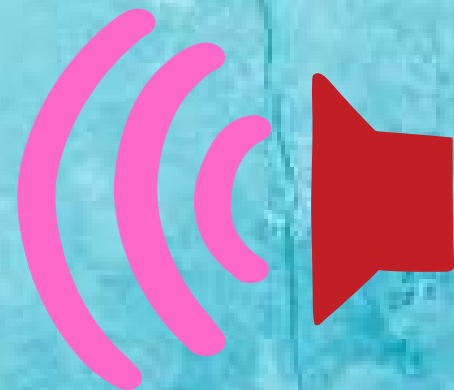




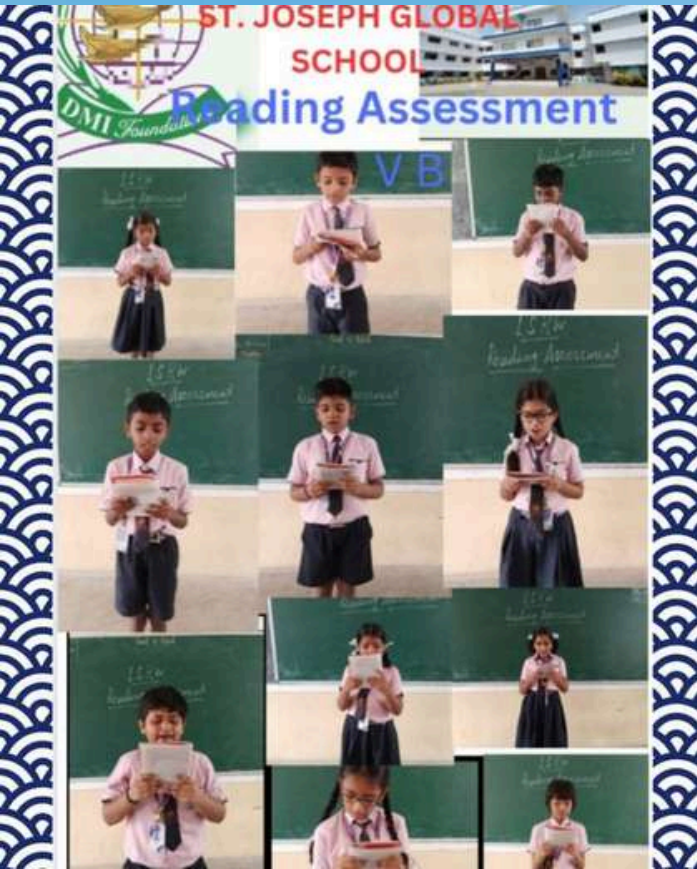
# LISTENING

4. **Empathetic Listening:** Understanding and sharing the speaker's emotions.

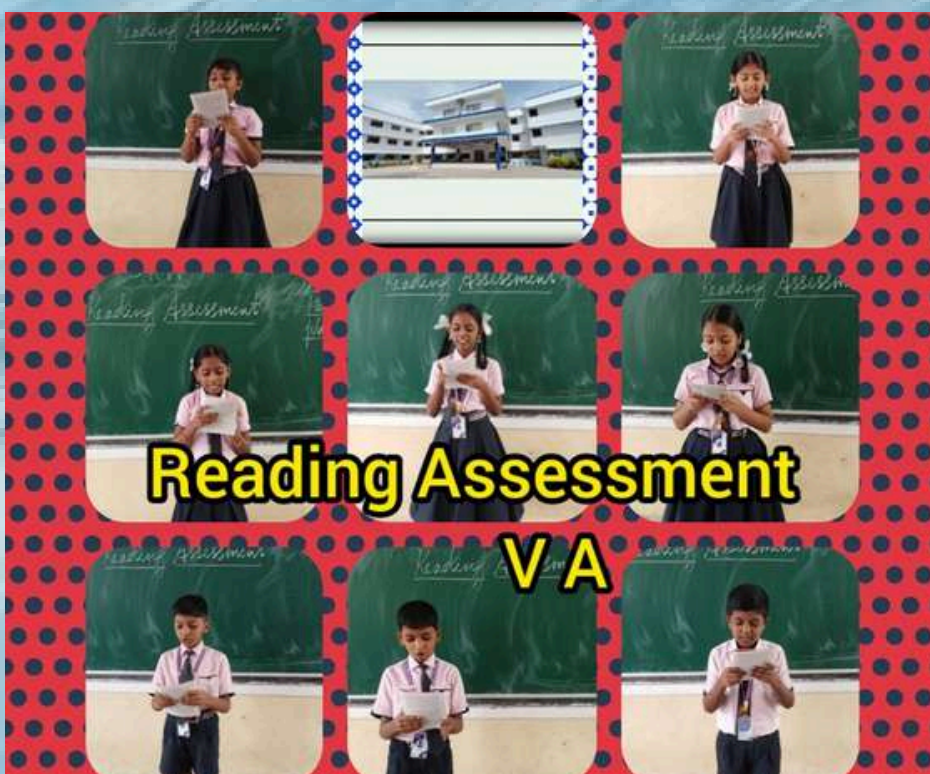
